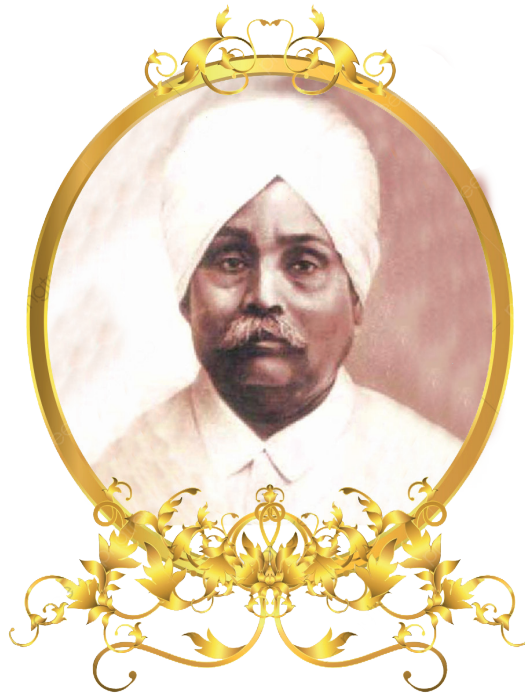

VISIONARY PAR EXCELLENCE

Lala Lajpatrai was one of the foremost freedom fighters and was born on 28th January 1865 in Dhudike Village in Ferozpur District of Punjab. Lala Lajpatrai was known for his single minded zeal and devotion to the Indian Nationalist cause. Whilst, the rest of the Indian Leaders bowed before the British rule, he took up the battle and challenged the might of the British Empire for which he had to pay the ultimate price with his life.

From a management perspective, he believed in India's economic regeneration and eventual resurgence as an economic power. Lalaji was fearless and candid in expressing his view. Lalaji was an educationist, a visionary and a pioneer who gave shape to India's education system. He played a major role in India's struggle for independence and patriots like him can never be forgotten. When Lalaji died on 17th November 1928, Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation in his tribute to Lalaji exclaimed, "Men like Lalaji cannot die as long as the sun shines in the Indian Sky". It offers a serene atmosphere for the management students to pursue their education in the best ambience with the most optimal resources at their disposal.

Lala Lajpatrai Institute of Management offers the MMS-Master of Management Studies (Two years full time) course, approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi. The Institute is affiliated to the University of Mumbai and recognized by Government of Maharashtra.

The Doctoral Program (Ph.D.) of University of Mumbai is offered at the Institute and is visualized to contribute significantly to the knowledge management process at LLIM. It is also identified as a totally enriching and mutually rewarding experience for the doctoral scholars and guides a like.

MMS - MASTER OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES

The objective of this program is to prepare individuals to develop into Managers for tomorrow as per the needs of the industry. The two year duration course is offered on a full-time basis. The MMS Program prepares students with the skills, knowledge and strategic perspectives essential for the leadership of business anywhere in the world. The course is intellectually demanding and is being taught by faculty who encourage active student participation in the classrooms through presentations, case discussions, etc. The curriculum, in the first year is common for all & in the second year students opt for specialization viz Marketing, Finance, Human Resource Management & Operations.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Admissions are open to all students who have a Bachelors Degree from a recognized University with a minimum score of 50 percent and have appeared for the qualifying Common Entrance Test (CMAT / XMAT

/ SNAP / CET / NMAT / GMAT / ATMA). After Test, the students have to undergo Group Discussion & Personal Interview. The Institute follows the directions laid down by the Government of Maharashtra & University of Mumbai for the intake of students. The intake is strictly on the basis of Merit received by the student in Common Entrance Test (CET).

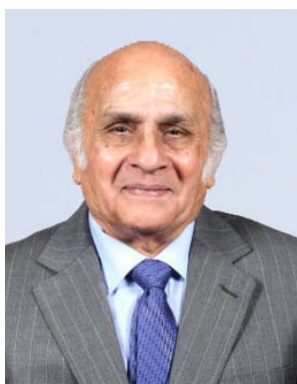

OPERATIONS STRATEGIES IN A GLOBAL ECONOMY - 13TH DECEMBER, 2024.



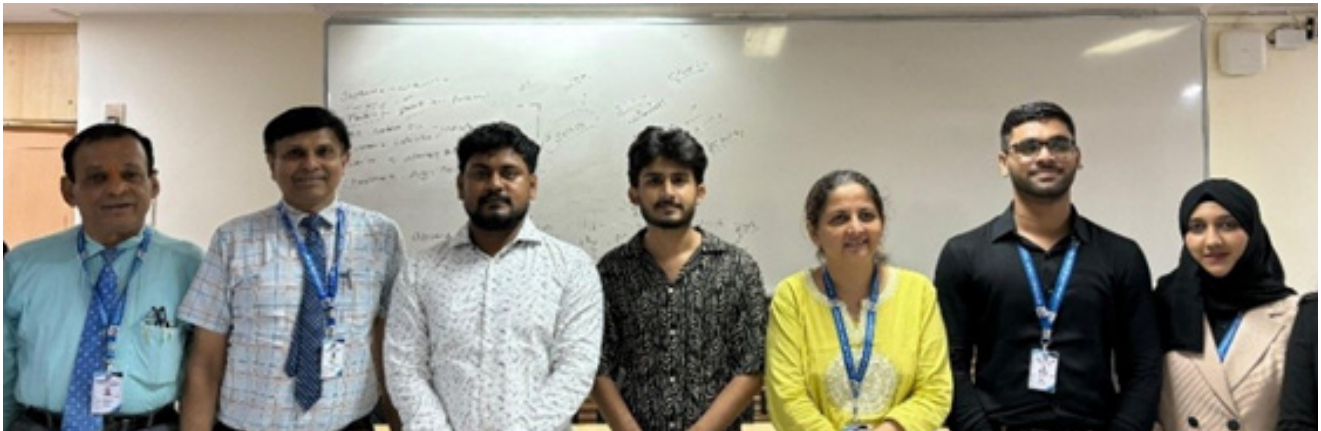

A vote of thanks was delivered by Dr. Suresh Suvarna.

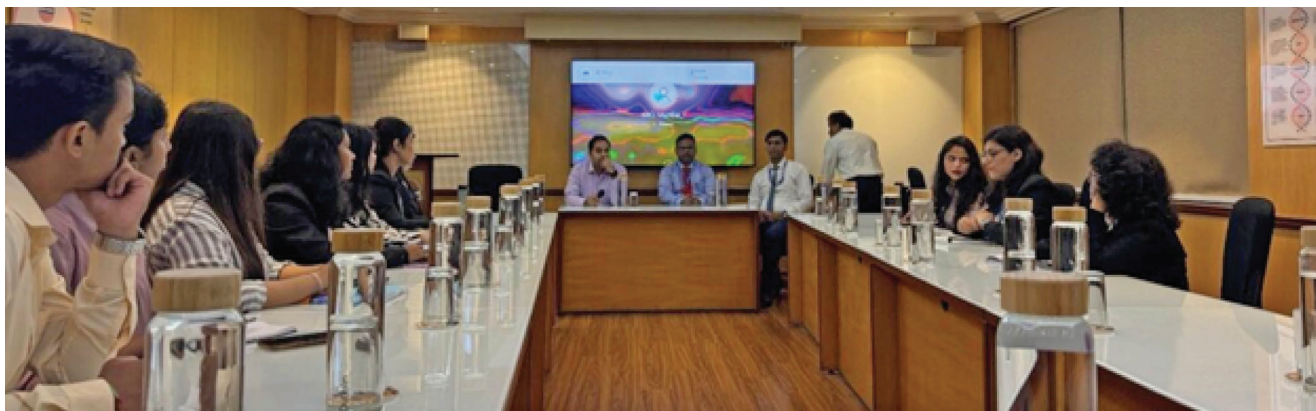
This was followed by cultural performances by second-year students, including dances and musical acts, creating an engaging and entertaining environment for the newcomers.

PROJECTS & PRESENTATIONS

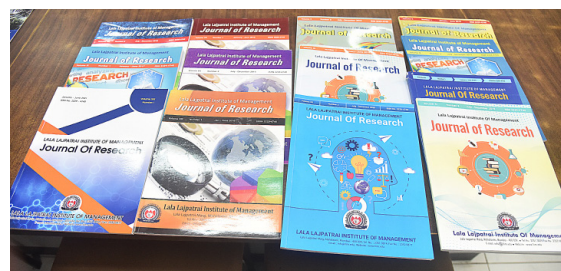

No. ARP 2023/CR.51/TE4.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. XXVIII of 2015), the Government of Maharashtra hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission to the Full Time Professional Undergraduate Technical Courses) Rules, 2017, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission to the Full Time Professional Undergraduate Technical Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2023.

2. In rule 2 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission to the Full Time Professional Undergraduate Technical Courses) Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), in sub-rule (1), in clause (g), after the word “Pharmacy” the letters and words and bracket “ , Pharmacy (Practice),” shall be inserted.

3. In rule 5 of the principal Rules, in sub-rule (1), in the table –

(i) in Type A in column (2) relating to “Eligibility Criteria”, in entry at (a) (i) after the words “Diploma in Engineering” the words “or D. Voc” shall be inserted ;

(ii) in Type E in column (2) relating to “Eligibility Criteria”, in entry at (a), after the words “HSC Examination” the words “or Diploma in Engineering or D.Voc.” shall be inserted ;

(iii) in Type E in column (2) relating to “Eligibility Criteria”, in entry at (b), after the words “Pharmacy” the words “or Bachelor of Science” shall be inserted ;

4. In rule 8 of the principal Rules, in sub-rule (3),—

(i) in clause (g), before the existing sub-clause (i) the following sub-clause shall be inserted, namely:-

“(i-a) for admission to the first year planning the preference for admission shall be given in following order ,—

(a) Candidates passing 10+2 examination as well as CET conducted by Competent Authority;

(b) Candidates passing D. Voc.;

(c) Candidates passing 10+2 examination.”;

(iii) after clause (g), the following clauses shall be inserted, namely,-

“(h) For admission to First Year of the Bachelor of Design.— The merit list for the Candidates as per sub-rules (1) to (3) and sub-rule (6) of rule 5 shall be prepared on the basis of marks or score secured by the Candidate in the CET conducted by the Competent Authority or marks or score secured in any other examination conducted by the concerned appropriate authority for the purpose of admission to these Courses:

Provided that, in case of tie, the relative merit of Candidates shall be resolved in the

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following order of preference and methodology as specified below,-

- (a) higher percentage of marks in Aggregate at HSC;

- (d) higher percentage of marks in the subject Science at SSC.

(i) For Admission to First Year of Bachelor of Pharmacy (Practice),-

The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the Candidate on the basis of which Diploma is awarded by the examining authority:

Provided that, in case of tie, the relative merit of different Candidates shall be resolved in the following order of preference and the methodology as specified below,-

- (a) higher percentage of marks in Aggregate at HSC;
- (b) higher percentage of marks in Physics at HSC;
- (c) higher percentage of marks in Chemistry at HSC;
- (d) higher percentage of marks in SSC;
- (e) higher percentage of marks in Science at SSC.”

5. In rule 10 of the principal Rules, —

(i) in sub-rule (1), for the clause (a),—

(a) in Stage VIII, for clause (ii), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(ii) In case of Direct Admission to Second Year (Lateral Entry) of Engineering and Technology, if the seats remain vacant after allotment to all the Diploma in Engineering Candidates based on *Inter-Se-Merit*, such seats shall be filled in on the basis on *Inter-Se-Merit* of the Bachelor of Science Candidates. Thereafter, if the seats remain vacant after allotment to all the Bachelor of Science Candidates based on *Inter-se-Merit*, such seats shall be filled in on the basis of *Inter-se-Merit* of the D. Voc. Candidates.”

(b) for the Stage-IX, following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Stage-IX: For First year admissions, after completion of Stage VIII, if the seats remain vacant then such vacant seats shall be considered for allotment in the following order of preference as per the Eligibility Conditions and Requirements:-

- (a) Diploma Candidates based on *Inter-se-Merit*;
- (b) D.Voc. Candidates based on *Inter-se-Merit*.”;

(ii) in sub-rule (2),

(a) for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) First Year Engineering – JEE (Main) for B.E. or B.Tech and then if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of CET score, thereafter if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of Diploma in Engineering marks, thereafter if the seats still remain vacant, on the basis of D.Voc. marks;”

(b) for clauses (d) and (e), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:-

“(d) First Year Hotel Management and Catering Technology.- NCI-IM JEE conducted by the National Testing Agency and if seats remain vacant on the basis of CET Score, thereafter if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of D. Voc. marks;



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(e) First Year Planning - JEE (Main) B. Planning and then if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of CET score, thereafter if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of D. Voc. marks and if seats still remains vacant, on the basis of 10 +2 examination marks;";

(c) after clause (e), for the following clause shall be added, namely :-

"(f) First Year Design - on the basis of CET score and then if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of D. Voc. marks.".

6. In rule 12 of the principal rules, in sub-rule (a) for the letters and words and letters "CAP Round - I and II" at both the places, where they occur the letters and words and letters "CAP Round - I, II and III" shall be substituted.

MAHARASHTRA UNAIDED PRIVATE PROFESSIONAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSIONS AND FEES) ACT, 2015.

No.Niyam-2025/C.R.65/TE-4.— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 and Section 23 read with sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. XXVIII of 2015), the Government of Maharashtra hereby makes the following rules to amend the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission to the Full Time Professional Undergraduate, Post Graduate, Integrated or Dual Degree Technical Courses) Rules, 2024, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission to the Full Time Professional Undergraduate, Post Graduate, Integrated or Dual Degree Technical Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2025.

2. In rule 9 of the principal Rules, in sub-rule (3),—

(1) for the heading “ Conduct of CAP Rounds II and III.” the following heading shall be substituted, namely :—

“ Conduct of CAP Rounds II, III and IV.—” ;

(2) for clauses (a) and (b), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely :—

“(a) The seats available for Rounds II, III and IV shall be published on the website by the CET Cell. The candidates eligible for respective Rounds II, III and IV are allowed to fill in and/or edit online option form filled in by the candidate for the previous round. The seats to be allotted during these rounds shall be available to the Eligible Candidate falling under the following categories.—

(i) candidates as per the clauses (d) and (e) of sub-rule (2) of this rule for Round-II and candidates as per the sub-clauses (iv) and (v) of clause (b) sub-rule (3) of this rule for Rounds III and IV ;

(ii) candidates who have not been allotted any seat in any of the previous rounds ;

(iii) candidates who did not participate (failure of filling option form) in previous rounds.” ; ”

(b) (i) Candidates, who have been allotted seat other than first preference in Round-I, first three preferences in Round-II, first six preferences in Round-III and reported to ARC or self-scrutinised the document uploaded in online application system for confirmation of seat acceptance, whilst filling fresh option form for subsequent Round, he need not fill the preference already allotted to the candidate in the previous round. Once upward preference is allotted to such candidate, his earlier seat allotment shall stand automatically cancelled. In the event of no such upward preference is allotted, his previous allotment stands retained ;

(ii) If a candidate is allotted the seat as per his first three and six preferences, in Round-II and Round-III, respectively, such allotment shall be auto freezed and the candidate shall accept the allotment so made. After the acceptance such candidate shall not be eligible for participation in the subsequent CAP rounds. Such candidates shall then report to the ARC

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for verification of documents or the candidate may scrutinize the document uploaded in online application system himself and such candidate shall make payment of seat acceptance fee by online mode. Thereafter such candidates shall report to the allotted institute and seek admission to the allotted seat. If the candidate does not report to ARC or fails to carry out self scrutiny of the document uploaded in online application system for confirmation of seat acceptance, then his claim on the allotted seat shall stand forfeited automatically and the seat shall become available for fresh allotment. The allotment so made shall be the final allotment for such candidate ;

(iii) Candidate who have been allotted seat other than the first three and six preferences given by the candidate in Round-II and Round-III, respectively and if the candidate is satisfied with such allotment and do not wish to participate in further CAP rounds, such candidate may freeze the offered seat through candidate's login. Once the candidate freezes the allotted seat, such candidate shall then report to the ARC or the candidate may scrutinize the document uploaded in online application system himself and make payment of seat acceptance fee by online mode. Thereafter, such candidate shall report to the allotted institute and seek admission on the allotted seat. For such candidate, the allotment so made shall be the final allotment. If such candidate does not report to ARC or fails to carry out self-scrutiny of the document uploaded in online application system for confirmation of seat acceptance, his claim on the allotted seat shall stand forfeited automatically and the seat shall become available for fresh allotment. Such candidate shall then be not eligible for participation in the subsequent CAP rounds ;

(iv) Candidate who have been allotted seat in other than the first three and six preferences given by the candidate in Round-II and Round-III, respectively and accepted the seat by reporting to ARC or by self-scrutinising the document uploaded in online application system for confirmation of seat acceptance, shall be eligible for participation in the subsequent rounds for betterment ;

(v) Candidate who have been allotted seat in other than the first three and six preferences given by the candidate in Round-II and Round-III, respectively and not accepted the seat by not reporting to ARC or fails to carry out self-scrutiny of the document uploaded in online application system for confirmation of seat acceptance shall be eligible for participation in the subsequent rounds. ” ;

(3) in clause (c), for the word and letters “ Round III ” wherever they occurred, the word and letters “ Round IV ” shall be substituted.

3. In rule 10 of the principal Rules, in sub-rule (2), in clause (i) for sub-clause (d), the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

“ (d) First Year Design.— On the basis of score of the Undergraduate Common Entrance Examination (CET) for Design (UCEED) examination conducted by the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) and then if the seats remain vacant, on the basis of D. Voc. marks.” ;

4. In rule 11 of the principal Rules,—

(1) for the heading “ Allotment of seats by CAP Rounds I, II and III.—” the following heading shall be substituted, namely :—

“ Allotment of seats by CAP Rounds I, II, III and IV.—” ;

(2) in sub-rule (1), for the letters and words “ CAP Rounds I, II and III ” the words and letters “ CAP Rounds I, II, III and IV ” shall be substituted ;

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(3) in sub-rule (3), for the heading “ CAP Round II ”, the following heading shall be substituted, namely :—

“ CAP Rounds II and III ” ;

(4) in sub-rule (4), for the heading “ In CAP Round III.— ” the following heading shall be substituted namely :—

“ In CAP Round IV.— ” (5) in sub-rule (6), for the letters and words “ CAP Round I, II and III ” the letters and words “ CAP Rounds I, II, III and IV ” shall be substituted.

5. In rule 12 of the principal Rules,—

(1) in clause (a) for the words and letters “ CAP Rounds I, II and III ” the words and letters “ CAP Rounds I, II, III and IV ” shall be substituted ;

(2) after clause (p), following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“ (q) Admission to Under Graduate/Post Graduate Dual Degree/Integrated Courses through collaborative / twinning mode.—

(i) Eligibility for admission to First Year of Under Graduate/Post Graduate /Dual Degree/Integrated Courses through collaborative/twinning mode shall be same as admission to first year of respective professional Under Graduate/Post Graduate Dual Degree /Integrated Courses and it is as per the additional norms, if any, prescribed from time to time by the Appropriate Authority.

(ii) Lateral Entry and supernumerary seats shall not be allowed in Foreign Collaboration and Twinning Programme.

(iii) Candidates shall apply for admissions to these courses to the Competent Authority.

(iv) Admissions to these courses shall be made by the institutes, as per rule 13 of these rules. ” ;

6. In rule 13 of the principal Rules,—

(i) in clause (a), after the words “Admissions shall be made in a transparent manner ” the words “after the CAP Rounds ” shall be inserted ;

(ii) in clause (c), after the words “ Institution shall invite applications ” the words “ till the date of allotment of final CAP Round ” shall be inserted ;

(iii) after clause (d), following proviso shall be added, namely :—

“ Provided that, in case candidate is unable to submit the application directly to the concerned institution for any reason, the candidate shall have the opportunity to apply through the website of the Competent Authority till the date of allotment of final CAP Round. These applications will be forwarded to the respective institutions after the allotment process of CAP Round-IV. The concerned institution shall consider such applications while preparing the *Inter-Se-Merit*.”.

7. In rule 15 of the principal Rules,— for clauses (a) and (b), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely :—

“(a) The Candidate shall apply online for cancellation and submit duly signed copy of system generated application for cancellation of admission, to the Institution. Once the candidate submits online request for cancellation, his admission shall be treated as cancelled. The Institute shall consider the online request made by candidate for cancellation as final, irrespective of whether he has submitted duly signed copy of system generated application to the Institute. Upon such cancellation, the candidate shall lose the claim on the seat and



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such seat shall become available for further allotment. If the candidate cancels admission on or before the last day for cancellation of seats with full fees refund as specified by the Competent Authority, the Institute shall refund the entire fees to the candidate after deduction of rupees one thousand only towards processing charges and return all his original documents submitted to the Institute within two days from submission of duly signed copy of system generated application to the Institute.

(b) Candidate shall not be entitled to any refund of his/her fee except the Security Deposit and Caution Money Deposit if the online cancellation is effected by the candidate after the last day for cancellation of seats with full fee refund as specified by the Competent Authority. Link for online cancellation for admission shall be deactivated after cut-off date. Candidate has to apply for cancellation of admission to the institute by submitting application to the Institute after the cut-off date ;".
